2. Fire and EMT Career & Technical Education Courses

Don Monroe, CTE Director, provided details on the Public Safety Fire and EMT courses that were recently added at CCHS. Students are able to receive dual certification in Public Safety 1, EMT 1&2 and Fire 1&2.

Wayne Turner, Instructor, thanked the volunteers and staff who have helped him with the program. There is a lot of student interest. Students can take public safety skills into other career areas.

Several students spoke about the program and their future careers in the medical field.

Lower Currituck and Crawford Township Fire Departments recently donated 20 sets of turn out gear including breathing apparatuses. This would have cost the district several thousands of dollars if purchased new. They also offer their assistance and expertise in the classroom.

Item 2B Graduation Rates - Superintendent Stefanik announced JP Knapp Early College was recently recognized by the SBE for having a graduation rate in excess of 95% plus. The Early College rate is 95.3%. CCHS has a high rate of 90.7% with the state average at 91.3%. Out of 116 school districts in the state, Currituck tied 13th highest in the state.
