COVID Reopening Press Release PreK-5 ONLY

For Immediate Release

On October 6th, the Currituck County School Board reviewed four options for instructional models for the second nine weeks. The BOE voted in favor of Option 2. This means for PreK-5: a return to full-time, in-person instruction four days per week and ½ day remote instruction every Friday.

The full presentation made to the Board of Education has been posted to the district website.

Important next steps include:

• October 7-9

- The Virtual Learning Survey will reopen on our website for PreK-5 families to reassess their decision based on the plan voted upon last night.
- A Virtual Learning Teacher Application will open for PreK-5 staff who would like to teach in the Virtual Learning setting.
- A Bus Registration Form will be posted to our website for PreK-5 families to complete who have chosen to return to in-person instruction and require transportation.

- o End of the Grading Period

October 19-20

Teacher Workdays - No School for Students

October 21st

o Orientations Scheduled for all PreK-5 families

October 22nd & 23rd (both full days of in-person school)

- o 10/22: PreK-5 students with last names A-M will go to school
- 10/23: PreK-5 students with last names N-Z will go to school
- Family groups will be permitted to attend together.
- o All virtual students will begin school on October 22nd

• October 26th

All PreK-5 students will begin in-person instruction together.
