CCHS HONOR COURT OFFENSE / PENALTY GUIDELINES

(revised Fall 2017)

OFFENSES Determined by Levels as Follows: (the Court has the right to change as necessary)

1st Level – Quizzes, Homework, Giving/Sharing Answers, Group Projects (taking credit for work not completed and/or not doing your part), Unintentional Plagiarism

2nd Level – Test, Giving/Sharing Answers, Individual Projects, Dishonesty/Lying

- 3rd Level Intentional Plagiarism, Stealing Answers, Changing Grades, Multiple Cheating
 - Prior offenses will be given consideration when penalties are decided.
 - Second offense will result in an office referral.

PENALITIES

(the Court has the right to change as necessary)

- 1st Level : Notification to all teachers and parent/guardian of the student
 - Documentation/Letter placed in student's office folder
 - Automatic Zero for Assignment
 - Notification/Suggested Removal from appropriate clubs (BETA, Teen Court, sports, etc.)
- 2nd Level : All of the 1st Offense (above) Penalties
 - Not allowed test exemption (of subject violated) at the end of the semester (if cheating)
 - Parent/Teacher Conference and/or
 - Restitution/Community Service Determined by Hearing
- 3rd Level : All of the 1st and 2nd Offense (above) Penalties
 - Additional Restitution/Community Service Determined by Hearing and/or
 - Out of School Suspension as determined by the Court/Administrator
